Authors are requested to submit abstracts of up to 150 words, formatted in Times New Roman, font size 12, with 1.5 line spacing and 2.5 cm (1 inch) margins, in MS Word. Please include up to 5 keywords and email your abstract to nscbcom@gmail.com

Guidelines for Full Papers Submission

- ✓ **Length**: The full paper should be within a maximum of 5000 words, including references, tables, and charts.
- ✓ **Font and Spacing**: Use Times New Roman, font size 12, with 1.5 line spacing throughout the document.
- ✓ **Margins**: Set margins at 2.5 cm (1 inch) on all sides of the document.
- ✓ **Title and Author Information**: Include the title of the paper at the beginning, followed by the author(s) name(s) and affiliation(s).
- ✓ **Abstract and Keywords**: Begin with the abstract (not exceeding 150 words) and up to 5 relevant keywords.
- ✓ **Structure**: Organize the paper into clear sections such as Introduction, Literature Review, Objectives, Hypothesis, Methodology, Results & Discussion, Findings, Conclusion, and References.
- ✓ **Tables and Charts**: Number all tables and charts sequentially, provide a title for each, and include the source below.
- ✓ **References**: Use APA style for in-text citations and the reference list at the end of the paper.
- ✓ **Submission**: Submit the paper as a Word document to the designated email address nscbcom@gmail.com by the specified deadline.
