

### Guidelines for Full Papers Submission

- ✓ **Length:** The full paper should be within a maximum of 5000 words, including references, tables, and charts.
- ✓ **Font and Spacing:** Use Times New Roman, font size 12, with 1.5 line spacing throughout the document.
- ✓ **Margins:** Set margins at 2.5 cm (1 inch) on all sides of the document.
- ✓ **Title and Author Information:** Include the title of the paper at the beginning, followed by the author(s) names (s) and affiliation(s).
- ✓ **Abstract and Keywords:** Begin with the abstract (not exceeding 150 words) and up to 5 relevant keywords.
- ✓ **Structure:** Organize the paper into clear sections such as Introduction, Literature Review, Objectives, Hypothesis, Methodology, Results & Discussion, Findings, Conclusion, and References.
- ✓ **Tables and Charts:** Number all tables and charts sequentially, provide a title for each, and include the source below.
- ✓ **References:** Use APA style for in-text citations and the reference list at the end of the paper.
- ✓ **Submission:** Submit the paper as a Word document to the designated email address [nscbcom@gmail.com](mailto:nscbcom@gmail.com) by the specified deadline.
